John M. Kerr Memorial Bursary

Each year, the Imperial Sovereign Court of the Wild Rose grants bursary awards to students of the LGBTQ2S+ community in any accredited post-secondary education program within the Province of Alberta.

The bursary was established by Her Imperial Sovereign Majesty, Empress 8 and 17, to honour the memory of a close friend of Edmonton's gay community and a strong supporter of drag entertainment in our city. The Bursary Fund is supported through ongoing fundraising efforts by the Court and is managed as a separate account by the Board of the ISCWR.

The number of bursary award given, and amounts awarded can vary from year to year but average between \$500 - \$750. Recipients of an award are notified of their successful application and are asked to be present for the presentation of the awards during the annual Coronation Charity Ball.
